RESOLUTION NO. 10546

WHEREAS, on 5 April 2019, the President of the Republic of the Philippines approved Republic Act No. 11257 (RA No. 11257) entitled, "*An Act Separating the City of Mandaue from the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu to Constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue*";

WHEREAS, Section 3 of RA No. 11257 states that the Commission on Elections shall issue the necessary rules and regulations to implement the law within thirty (30) days after its effectivity;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of RA No. 11257 provides that the law shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation;

WHEREAS, RA No. 11257 was published in the Manila Bulletin on May 9, 2019, and therefore, became effective on May 24, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, by virtue of the powers vested in it by the 1987 Philippine Constitution and other relevant election laws, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVES**, to promulgate and approve the following "*Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA No. 11257 entitled, "An Act Separating the City of Mandaue from the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu to Constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue"*.

Section 1. Title. - These Rules and Regulations shall be referred to as the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 11257 entitled, "*An Act*

Separating the City of Mandaue from the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu to Constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue”

Section 2. Reapportionment of the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu. – The Sixth Legislative District of the province of Cebu shall be reapportioned as follows:

- a) The City of Mandaue shall be separated from the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu to constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue;
- b) The Sixth Legislative District shall be composed of the municipalities of Consolacion and Cordova.

Section 3. Incumbent Representative. - The incumbent Representative of the present Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu which includes the City of Mandaue shall continue to represent the said district until the noon of the 30th of June 2022.

Section 4. First Regular Elections. – The first regular elections in the new Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu and in the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue shall be held in the next national and local elections after the effectivity of RA 11257.

Section 5. Allocation of Members of the House of Representatives. – There shall be District Representatives in the House of Representatives for the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu and the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue, as follows:

Sixth Legislative District (Consolacion and Cordova)	1 District Representative
Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue	1 District Representative

Section 6. Allocation of Elective Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan. – The present allocation of elective Members of the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan* of the province of Cebu shall be maintained. Voters of the Lone Legislative District of the City of Mandaue shall continue to vote for Members, *Sangguniang Panlalawigan*, in the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu, along with the municipalities of Consolacion and Cordova.

Section 7. Allocation of Elective Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. – In line with Section 3 of Republic Act No. 6636, the number of elective Members of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* in the City of Mandaue shall be increased from ten (10) to twelve (12).

Section 8. Repealing Clause. - All rules and regulations inconsistent with this IRR are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 9. Publication. - The Education and Information Department (EID) of the Commission shall cause the publication of this IRR in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.

Section 10. Effectivity. - This IRR shall take effect on the seventh (7th) day after its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.
