INSTRUCTIONS TO INDIGENOUS PEOPLE (IP) VOTERS

STEP 1. The IP voter checks his/her Precinct and Sequence number in the PCVL-IP posted outside the polling place.

STEP 2. The IP voter approaches the EB Third Member to give his/her name, precinct and sequence number for verification purposes and fill out the **Authorization Form/Waiver (Annex "A")**.

STEP 3. The IP voter affixes his/her signature/thumbmark in the space provided in the EDCVL-IP Barangay or EDCVL-IP SK.

STEP 4. The IP voter shall be escorted by the Poll Clerk to go to the designated IP voters voting area and using a ballot secrecy folder, fill out his/her ballot/s.

STEP 5. The IP voter shall approach the Poll Clerk to have his/her fingernail or any other nail or suitable part of his/her body if unavailable, marked with indelible ink.

STEP 6. After voting, the IP voter shall approach the EB Chairperson who shall detach the ballot coupon/s and deposit the folded ballot/s in the compartment of the ballot box for valid ballots and the detached coupons in the compartment of the spoiled ballots.

STEP 7. The IP voter may leave the SVR.
