THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(Fourth Regular Session)

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the twenty-fourth day of April two thousand.

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 109]

“AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY PANGLIMA BADDIRI IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INDANAN, PROVINCE OF SULU, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Panglima Baddiri is hereby separated from its mother Barangay Kajatian in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu, and is created into a separated and distinct regular barangay in the same municipality and province.

SEC. 2. Barangay Panglima Baddiri is bounded by natural and duly designated boundaries, more specifically as follows:

“Bounded on the East along point 1 to 2 by Barangay Anoling of the Municipality of Patikul; on the South along point 2 to 3 by Barangay Tagbak; on the West along point 3 to 4 by Barangay Buansa; and on the North West along point 4 to 1 by Barangay Kajatian.”

SEC. 3. Immediately after the ratification of this Act, the punong barangay and seven (7) members of the sangguniang barangay shall be appointed by the mayor of Indanan Municipality; while, the chairman and seven (7) members of the sangguniang kabataan shall be appointed by the concerned punong barangay: Provided, That they shall hold office until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified in their next sangguniang regular elections: Provided, Further, That they shall exercise their duties and powers specified under Republic Act No. 6734, Muslim Mindanao Act. 25, and other existing rules and regulations.

SEC. 4. The corporate existence of Barangay Panglima Baddiri shall commence upon the appointment or election and qualification of the punong barangay and a majority of the sangguniang barangay members.

SEC. 5. The Sangguniang Bayan shall provide for the necessary allowances and other benefits of the appointed barangay officials out of the municipal funds until the regular allocation from the national government shall have been released to the new barangay.

SEC. 6. The Commission on Elections shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite which shall be held within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.

SEC. 7. The expenses required for the plebiscite shall be appropriated out of any available funds in the treasury of the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu, as may be determined by the sangguniang bayan.


SEC. 8. The creation of Barangay Panglima Baddiri shall take effect when approved by a majority of the votes cast in the plebiscite called for the purpose in the local government units directly affected.

SEC. 9. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


