EXECUTIVE ORDER }
No. 69. }

The attention of provincial governors and other officials concerned is hereby invited to the provisions of Executive Order Numbered Two, series of nineteen hundred and eleven, requiring the collection of historical data and the transmission thereof by each provincial governor to the Executive Bureau. No such data have been received from some provinces, while many others have sent those corresponding to only a few of the municipalities of the province.

In view of the evident importance of the acquisition of such data for the history of the Philippine Islands, it is hereby directed that all provincial governors of the provinces which have not to date forwarded to the Executive Bureau the complete historical data and documents called for in said Executive Order do so as promptly as practicable, and that every effort be made to obtain the best historical information possible.
