RULES ON THE IMPORTATION OF CERTAIN TYPES OF PASSENGER VEHICLES

Rule No. 3 is hereby modified to read

"Only passenger vehicles with a book value of at least US\$ 20,000.00 may be imported. The blue book/red book/world car value or similar reference shall be used in determining the dutiable value for the imported passenger vehicle. Hence, the dutiable value therefor shall be at least US\$ 20,000.00 plus cost of freight, insurance, and other dutiable charges."

Rule No. 13 is hereby modified to read

"In accordance with Sec. 3 of Central Bank Circular importation of passenger vehicles, parts, and compone listed in Appendex 8 thereof, shall require the appropriclearance/permits from the DTI/BIS. All applications permit to import passenger vehicles under these Ru processed and acted upon by the DTI/BIS within from receipt of the application. The application include a sworn statement that the importer unders accepts these Rules on importation and shall abid he same. The permit shall be presented to an authori nt for purposes of opening a letter of credit, releasing the imported passenger vehicle from the Bure: Customs after all the taxes and duties thereon paid."
