PROCLAMATION No. 391

DECLARING SATURDAY, MARCH 2, 1957, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE AND THE CITY OF ILOILO

WHEREAS, the sixty-sixth birthday anniversary of the late Tomas Confesor, one of our most outstanding resistance leaders during the last war, falls on Saturday, March 2, 1957; and

WHEREAS, the people of Iloilo, his birthplace, desire that they be given full opportunity to celebrate his birthday anniversary with appropriate ceremonies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ramon Magsaysay, President of the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested in me by section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby declare Saturday, March 2, 1957, as a special public holiday in the province and the city of Iloilo.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 1st day of March, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the eleventh.
