PROCLAMATION NO. 96

DECLARING FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 1966, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC  
HOLIDAY IN GUINOBATAN, ALBAY.

WHEREAS, Friday, September 2, 1966, marks the  
101st birthday anniversary of General Simeon Clay  
Arbolada, one of the last Filipinos to surrender during  
the Filipino-American war; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guinobatan, Albay, request  
that they be afforded an opportunity to render homage  
to the honored general;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President  
of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested  
in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code,  
do hereby declare Friday, September 2, 1966, as a special  
public holiday in Guinobatan, Albay.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and  
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be  
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 31st day of August,  
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
