PROCLAMATION NO. 264

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 1967, AS A SPECIAL
PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE.

WHEREAS, Wednesday, September 13, 1967, marks
the anniversary of the Battle of Pulang Lupa 67 years
ago at Torrijos, Marinduque, where a handful of Filipinos
scored one of the most notable military victories in the
Filipino-American War; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Province of Marinduque
should be afforded the opportunity to commemorate this
important event in their country's history the more to
inspire them to greater deeds for their country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President
of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested
in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code,
do hereby declare Wednesday, September 13, 1967, as a
special public holiday in the Province of Marinduque.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 12th day of
September, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred
and sixty-seven.
