**WHEREAS**, Wednesday, July 2, 2003 marks the 430<sup>th</sup> *Foundation Day* anniversary of the City of Pasig;



**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


