[ REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11182 ]

AN ACT MOVING THE DATE OF "CATARMAN DAY" TO AUGUST 30 OF EVERY YEAR, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9203, ENTITLED "AN ACT DECLARING THE FIFTEENTH (15<sup>TH</sup>) DAY OF AUGUST OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CATARMAN, PROVINCE OF CAMIGUIN, TO BE KNOWN AS 'CATARMAN DAY'"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 9203 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. August 30 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in the Municipality of Catarman, Province of Camiguin, to commemorate its foundation day anniversary, to be known as 'Catarman Day'."

SEC. 2. The Municipal Government of Catarman in the Province of Camiguin shall disseminate to its component barangays, as well as to the Provincial Government of Camiguin, through means it deems proper and expedient, the change of the date of Catarman Day, for proper coordination of activities.


SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.


